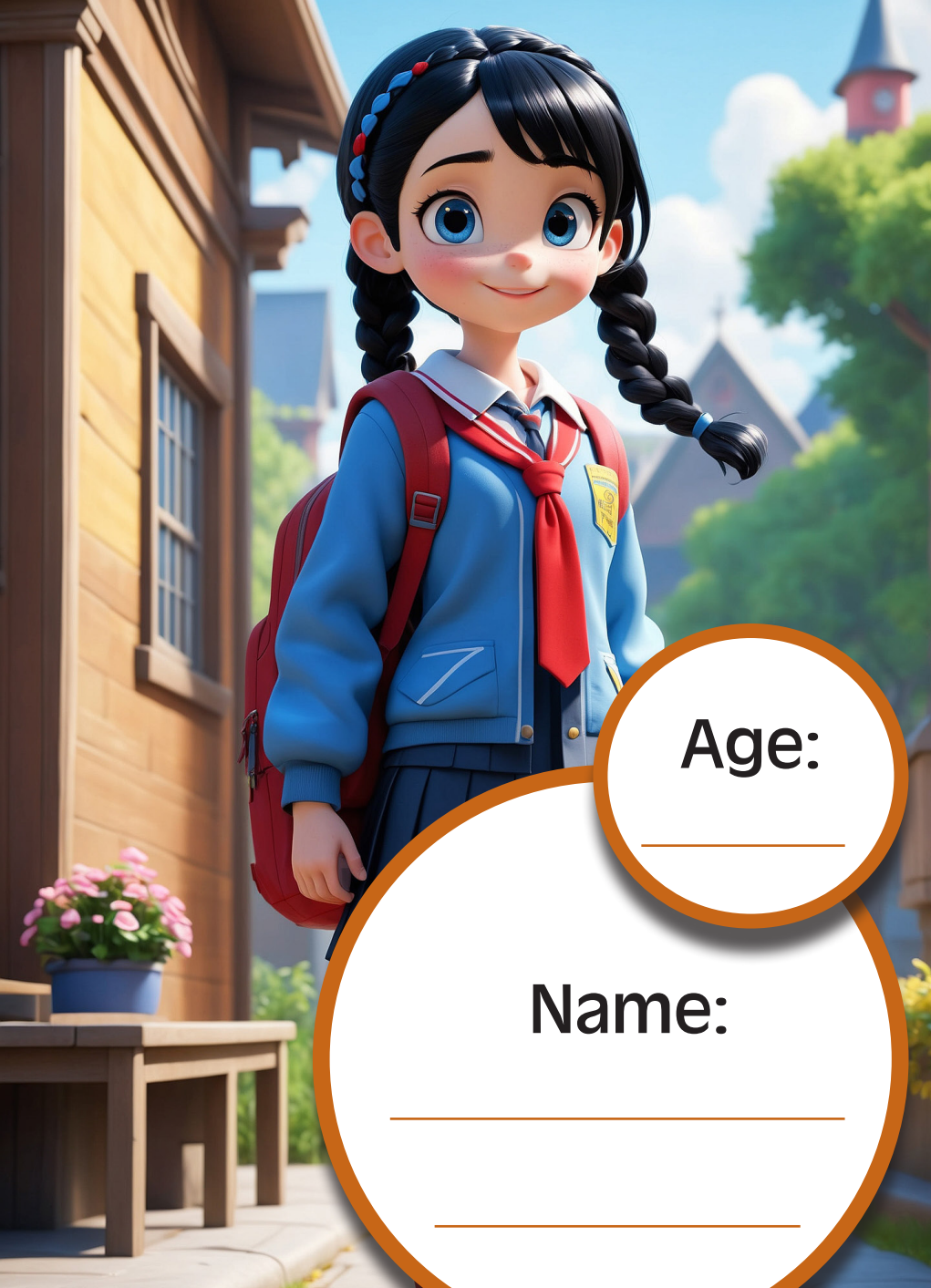

3. Worship Shows Respect To God As Our Creator. Bowing down and worshipping shows that we honour God who made us (Psalm 95:6).
4. Worship Helps You Know Who God Is. When you worship, you learn to honour and understand God better (Psalm 29:2).
5. God Is Happy When You Praise Him. When you praise God, He's happy and loves to be with you (Psalm 100:2).

6. Praise Reminds You Of How Great God Is. Singing and praising God helps you remember that He's mighty and so wonderful (Psalm 145:3).

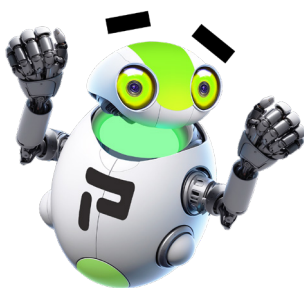

Seven Names Of The Holy Spirit

When Jesus talked about the Holy Spirit in John 14:16, He called Him the Comforter. The word Comforter comes from the Greek word, *paracletos*, which means “someone called to be by your side.” That means the Holy Spirit is always with you to help you! Here are some other names that show what He does:

Comforter – He makes you feel safe and peaceful.

Counsellor – He gives you good advice and shows you what to do.

Helper – He helps you in everything.

Intercessor – He prays through you and with you.

Advocate – He speaks up for you.

Strengthener – He gives you power and strength.

Standby – He’s always ready to help you anytime!

“But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth” (Acts 1:8).
