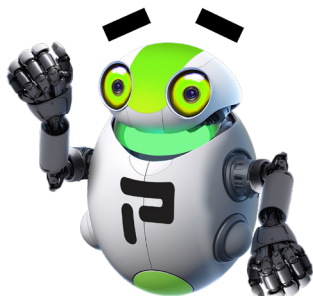

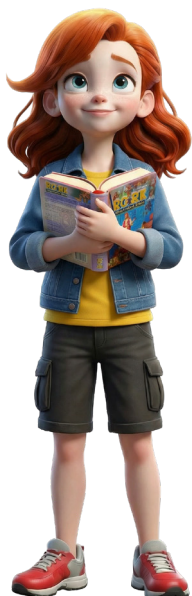

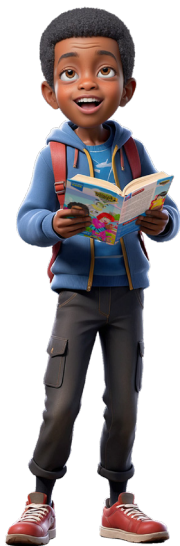

This was one of the signs Jesus talked about in Mark 16:17. Speaking in tongues has many wonderful benefits! Let's look at some of them:

### **1. It builds up your faith – Jude 1:20**

When you speak in tongues, you become stronger inside and grow in your faith. It's like giving your spirit a workout that makes you better and stronger every time!

### **2. It helps you speak mysteries – 1 Corinthians 14:2**

When you speak in tongues, you say secret things that only God understands. Amazing things happen in and around you—only good things!

### **3. It helps you praise God – Acts 10:46**

Speaking in tongues is a special way to worship God with pure and perfect words from your heart. It's not limited by human language—it's the language of the Spirit!

### **4. It helps you talk to God directly – 1 Corinthians 14:2, 14:15**

When you pray in tongues, you're speaking straight to God. That's why it's great to pray in tongues first before using your normal words—it helps you pray the best way possible!
