The Bible is a big book, and it's one of the oldest books in the world. It is read by a lot of people, including children too.


The Bible is God's Book, and it has beautiful things God wants you to know about Him.

Goliath was a giant and a bully too. He bragged about his strength and talked roughly to God's people. He thought nobody could defeat him.

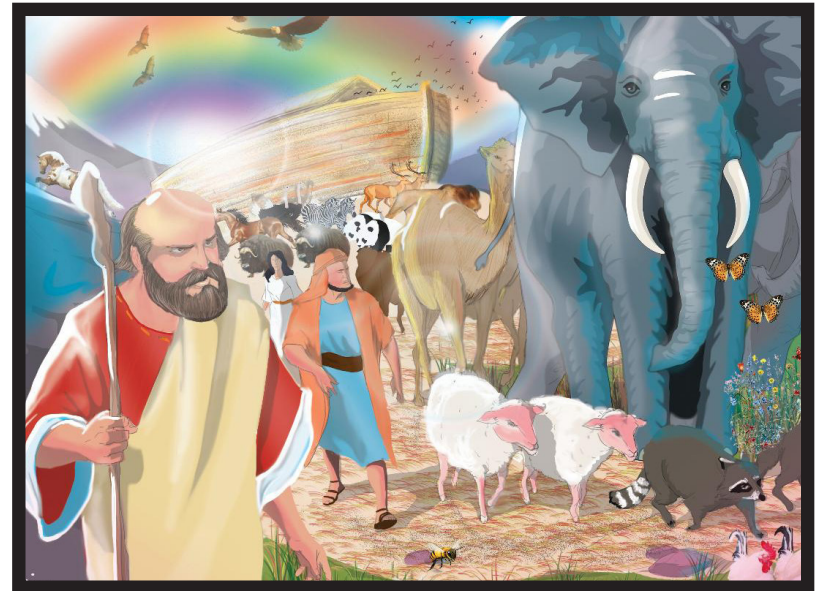
Guess what? A little boy, named David, defeated him with a sling and a small stone. Goliath fell down with His face in the dust. Phew!
